Eligible candidates:

- + Have acquired 180 credits and have at least 5 years of professional experience in a relevant field to be recognised as VAE (Validation of Acquired Experience) or
- + Have conducted studies of at least 300 credits (in Social Sciences, Economics, Political Science, Law, Communication and Language Studies)

The number of participants is limited to 25 students.

Flexibility is ensured.

- Classes take place from Monday to Friday during the evenings and on Saturday mornings.
- Training is intensive, and students can choose to take modules adapted to their immediate career needs and interests.

Participants can choose to follow :

- The entire program (60 credits) in one academic year or to spread the courses over 2 academic years.
